Year 3

Throughout the year, we mainly focus on using French vocabulary that describes us. We begin by learning greetings and how to introduce ourselves. We focus on personal facts as we look at family members, age and birthdays. We also start to share opinions in French by describing our favourite playground games.

Year 4

Throughout the year, we move onto looking at French in general. We investigate where in the world French is spoken as well as describing things we see on the way to school and the weather. We express more opinions by describing our likes and dislikes before looking at food and animals.

Year 5

In French, we start the year looking at our local area by describing places in the locality and our journey to school. We build on our knowledge of food by expressing our opinions and learn about the planets in our solar system. We begin to develop more complex sentences and use more descriptives towards the end of the year.

Year 6

We start the year by looking at telling the time in French and linking this to the school day. We continue to build more complex sentences and use more description. We revisit food by looking at cafés and regional food in more detail.
