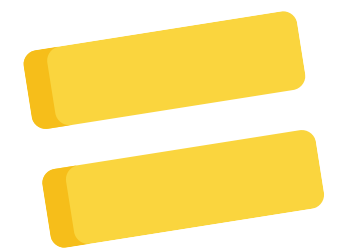
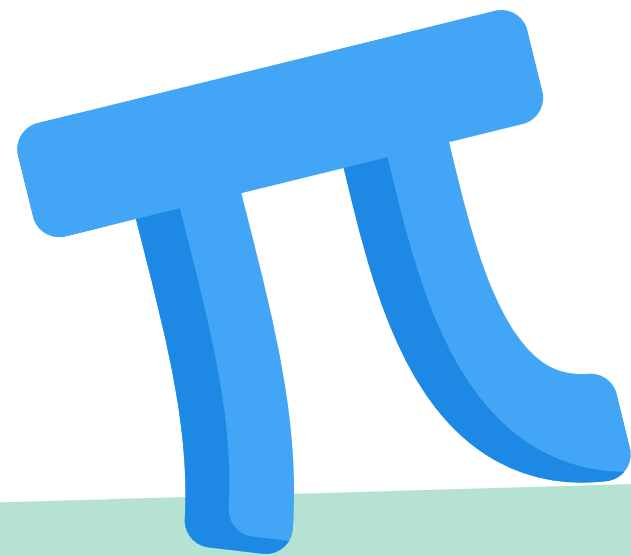
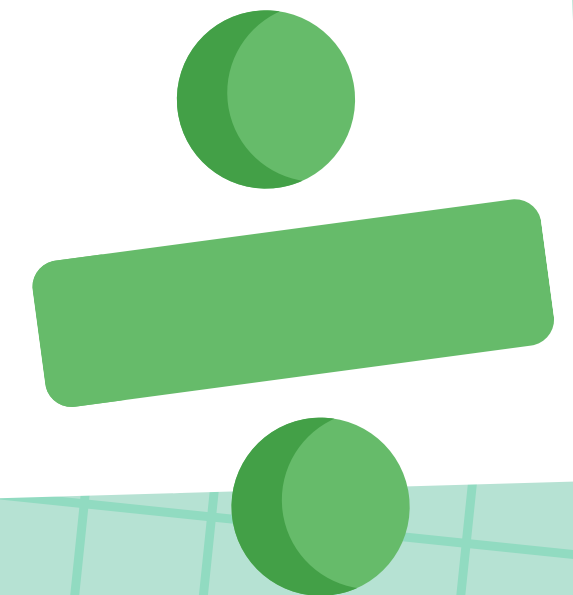

- To observe maths in action.

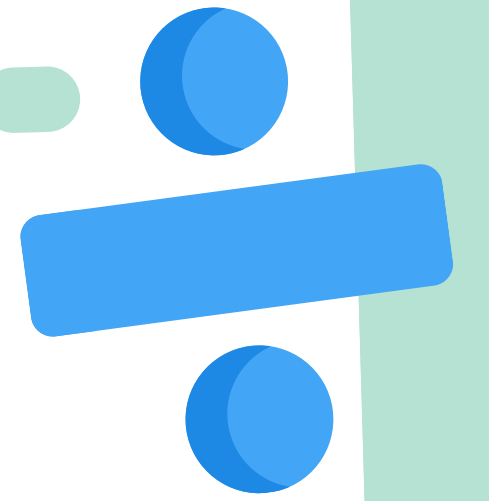
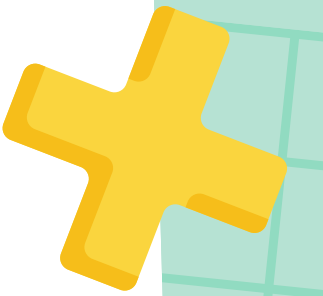


How is math delivered?

- Lessons are taught in an abstract and concrete way.
- Lessons are 30 minutes long with more opportunity for peer to peer learning.

Vocabulary

•Number sentence

•More, less, fewer

•Subitise! You will have hopefully heard this before.
Encourage children to use it at home.



Support at home

1. Practise counting daily. Stretch the children with counting on

2. Use number songs to help engagement (Jack Hartman, Numberblocks)

3. Practise number bonds to 10

4. Support with resources such as a number line - identify where you can see one more/less

5. Ask your child to explain how they have solved a problem, as this will demonstrate they have really understood the method used
