Impact of pupil premium grant on outcomes

- Just under 41% of children (175) pupils represented the school during the year in an Inter Sporting event and fully inclusive for both genders.
- 31 after school PE clubs were run this academic year.
- 421 pupils took part in before/after school clubs this year.
- 18 Year 6 PE leaders helped with event management and coaching.
- 33 Inter school's events attended this year.
- 8 Year 6 pupils reached either bronze or silver school games leader recognition.
- Introduced Flag football as part of the curriculum.
- 60 Young Leaders from Year 6 supported ll years at lunch time in sport.
- 30 Young leaders from year 6 supported sports week.
- 2nd Place in CAT Olympics.
- 2nd Place at Panathlon.
- 2nd Place at Boccia Even.
